2024-2025 Quail Season

OCTOBER 11, 2024 through FEBRUARY 16, 2025

License Requirement: Fort Mojave Indian Reservation hunt permit with quail selected. These are available at the Fort Mojave Indian Tribes Animal Control Office, located at 7500 Dike Road, Mohave Valley, AZ. This permit allows for the take of Gambel's quail and California quail male or female on the Fort Mojave Indian Reservation lands open to hunting during the hunt season only.

Legal Method of Take: Shotguns 12 gauge and smaller using shotshell, crossbow, bow and arrow and pneumatic firearms.

Dailey Bag Limit: Fifteen (15) quail per day in the aggregate.

Possession Limit: Forty-Five (45) quail in the aggregate after opening day.

Hunting hours: One-half (1/2) hour before sunrise to one-half (1/2) hours after sunset.

Identification: Hunters must leave one-fully feathered wing attached until reaching their final destination.

WARNING: *Your Hunting Permit is invalid if you are found hunting in the closed portions of residential sections of 12, 14 and 28. You will lose your hunting privileges for the remainder of season and be subject to citation and seizure of hunting equipment including firearms (SEE HUNT MAP for CLARIFICATION). Hunters found hunting in other closed areas of the Reservation may also be subject to citation and seizure of hunting equipment.*
